Eulàlia Rovira Biography

Eulàlia Rovira (Barcelona, 1985) has a degree in Fine Arts and a master's degree in Art in Context from the UdK-Berlin. Her practice follows the foundations that structure western rectitude and how they slowly petrify in bodies and language.

She has recently exhibited at Twin Gallery (Madrid), Capella de Sant Roc (Valls), La Panera Art Center (Lleida), M|A|C (Mataró), Maristany Art Center (Sant Cugat) and Injuve's Sala Amadís (Madrid). Since 2013 she collaborates with the artist Adrian Schindler. Together they have exhibited at the Musée de Bibracte (Saint-Léger-sur-Beuvray, FR), Sala Muncunill (Terrassa), Homesession and Fireplace (Barcelona), and in group exhibitions or screenings such as Galerie Martin Janda (Vienna), àngelsbarcelona, EtHall (l'Hospitalet), Turf Projects (Croydon, UK), Montehermoso Cultural Center (Vitoria), ZKU - Center for Art and Urbanistics (Berlin) and La Escocesa (Barcelona). In 2018 they were awarded with the Fundació Güell Visual Arts Grant.
