Richard Stipl (1968, Sternberk, República Txeca; viu i treballa a Praga) va començar el seu treball escultòric interpretant-se a si mateix. La seva obra s'enfoca exhaustivament en la naturalesa indefinida i les paradoxes inherents a l'acte de recrear-se contínuament al llarg de la vida. Les seves influències provenen de l'art religiós, la mitologia, però també l'art contemporani i l'*street art*.
