

## **Varvara & Mar**

Varvara & Mar es un dúo de artistas formado por Varvara Guljajeva y Mar Canet en 2009. A menudo, el trabajo del dúo está inspirado en la era digital. En su práctica, confrontan los cambios sociales y el impacto de la era tecnológica. Además de eso, Varvara & Mar están fascinados por la inteligencia artificial, la cinética, la participación del público y la fabricación digital, que son partes integrales de su trabajo.

El dúo de artistas ha exhibido sus obras de arte en varios espectáculos y festivales internacionales. Varvara & Mar ha expuesto en MAD de Nueva York, FACT de Liverpool, Santa Monica de Barcelona, Barbican y V&A Museum de Londres, Onassis Cultural Centre de Atenas, Ars Electronica museum de Linz, ZKM de Karlsruhe, etc.

Además de eso, el dúo ha completado varios encargos, como ENA (Nomen Nescio) (2021) en colaboración con el director de teatro Roger Bernat y por encargo del Teatro Lliure de Barcelona, Neuronal Landscapes (2018) para el Museo de Historia de Estonia, Wishing Wall (2014) para Google y Barbican en marcos de la exposición Digital Revolution, y más. En 2017 completaron una comisión de arte público en Tallin para el Teatro NUKU y recibieron varias veces el segundo y tercer premio de arte público en Estonia.

Varvara (Tartu, Estonia) ocupa el cargo de Profesor Asistente en Medios Computacionales y Artes en la Universidad de Ciencia y Tecnología de Hong Kong (GZ). Anteriormente ocupó cargos en la Academia de las Artes de Estonia y en la Escuela de Diseño ELISAVA de Barcelona. Varvara tiene un doctorado en arte de la Academia de las Artes de Estonia. Varvara también tiene un máster en medios digitales de ISNM en Alemania y una licenciatura en TI de Estonian IT College.

Mar (Barcelona) es doctorando en BFM en la Universidad de Tallin e investigador en Cudan Open Lab. Tiene dos títulos: en arte y diseño de ESDI en Barcelona y en desarrollo de juegos de ordenador de la Universidad Central Lancashire en Reino Unido. También obtuvo un máster de Interface Cultures en la Universidad de Arte y Diseño de Linz. Además de eso, Mar es cofundador de Derivart y Lummo.

Varvara y Mar son miembros de la Asociación de Artistas de Estonia.
